


### **Evolution of Public Input to the Environmental** Assessment process

- Industrialization is bad for the environment
- US National Environmental Policy Act 1969 (NEPA)
- **EU EIA Directive 1985/2011**
- **Equator Principals 2002**
- Public Access laws UNECE Aarhus Convention 2005
- "public" as key stakeholder, watch-dog and monitor







### Key highlights for US Approach - NEPA


- National Government Protector of Environment

## Key highlights for EU Approach – EU EIA Directive


- Government Protector of Environment
- UNECE Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-Making and Access to Justice In Environmental Matters
- (Aarhus Convention)
- Guarantees rights of public participation in decision making in environmental matters
- Public plays important role
- Access to information by NGOs
- Public holds governments accountable

- Links with IFC Performance Standards on:


