



#### Governance

- Civil Service Act; effective March 2008
- Decentralization of the administration of the atolls
  - Devolution of Ministry of Atolls Administration
  - Establishment of the new provincial system
- Changes to key ministries relevant to the Project
  - Ministry of Fisheries and Agriculture
    - Change in name only
  - Ministry of Housing Transport and Environment
    - Previously Ministry of Environment, Energy and Water







## Legal Instruments / Regulations

- Amendment to existing Fisheries Regulation
  - Description of penalties for effective implementation of the fishery management
- Draft New Fisheries Bill
  - Started work in 2002; submitted to Parliament in 2007; but was rejected; A revision was undertaken through consultative process. Revised one to be re-submitted in 2010
- Draft New Environmental Bill
  - Draft completed; open for public comments; to be submitted Parliament in 2010.

## Fisheries Management

#### Regional

- Indian Ocean Tuna Commission; Preparations for participating as a Non-contracting Cooperating Member completed. To be submitted in due course. Full member participation pending approval from the Parliament
- BOBP-IGO Full member

#### National

- Compliance on EU IUU Fishing Agreement; licensing of vessel and fish processors, issuing catch certificates to export consignments
- Third party certification process ongoing

## Fisheries Management ...


- National (contd..)
  - Fisheries Management Plans
    - Shark (NPoA) Draft completed, public consultations process to be started.
    - Groupers, preliminary plan completed
  - Extension of (local) Turtle Moratorium
    - 10 more years from August 2008; ban on harvest of turtle eggs during the moratorium period
    - IOSEA Turtle Moratorium (looks like Maldives would sign this soon?)

#### Resource Conservation

- Ban of Shark fishing
  - Effective March 2009, shark fishing is banned from within 12 mile of atoll boundaries.
  - Effective from March 2010 all shark fishing (targeted fishery) will be banned from the EEZ of Maldives
- Baa Atoll pilot atoll ecosystem conservation
  - Protected dive sites, bird roosting / nesting island

### Critical Habitat Protection

- National Biodiversity Target of 2010
  - Protect 5-10% of Maldives atoll area
- 31 Protected areas, dive sites, including reefs, islands, mangroves, and coastal areas
  - Eedhigalhi Kilhi, in Addu Atoll (South Maldives Seenu Atoll)
  - Protected Area; most recent been Angafaru, Hanifaru in Baa Atoll and South Maamigili Reef area in Ari Atoll (Central Maldives)
  - Proposed UNESCO Biosphere reserve, Baa Atoll
  - Proposal for managing protected areas through private sector participation



- 1. Most recent protected areas
- 2. Pilot activities of AEC Project
- 3. Proposed UNESCO Biosphere Reserve

## Mitigation of land-based pollution

- Development of island waste management centers (IWMCs)
  - Following tsunami, IWMCs have been constructed over 100+ islands.
- EU-supported pilot project to establish a regional waste management centre
  - ADH Atoll (for central region)  $\rightarrow$  study completed
  - MEMP North Central Region

## Data Collection, Compilation System

- MEMP GIS database; to be housed in Dept. of National Planning
  - GIS Web-based platform; terrestrial and coral reef monitoring data;
- Fisheries Statistics System
  - In response to EU-IUU Fisheries Agreement Compliance;
     Overhauling of fisheries data base;
    - Incorporation of log-books (first phase piloting complete); fishing vessel registry; computerizing of fisheries licensing; database for fish processing facilities;
- Compilation of EIA baseline data

  - To support local stake holders to pilot sustainable natural resource management and livelihood development practices in Baa Atoll

## Preparedness

- Strengthened Institutional reforms
  - Creation of Fishery Management Unit within MoFA
  - ERC evolved into EPA (Environmental Protection Agency)
  - MRC; more research focus
- Changes in representation of the Fishery Advisory Board
- HR and capacity developments in key ministries
  - MRC, MoFA, EPA, MHTE
- Greater involvement of the stake-holders and NGOs in decision making
  - Maldives Fish Exporters Association
  - Fishermen's Association
  - Province Offices (in future atoll / island councils)

## Preparedness ...

- National Task Force
  - Requires re-formulation in the light of the Government restructuring
- Project Advisory Panel
  - Needs to be created
- Project Steering Committee Members
  - Need the official nominations.

## **Priority Activities**

- Bait Fishery Research
  - Potential problem for development & management of tuna fisheries
  - Stock assessment, environmental effects of distribution and abundance
- Coral Reef Monitoring
  - Critical for fisheries and tourism.
- Adaptation measures for coastal erosion and mitigation
  - Coastal erosion, a difficult to issue to deal
- Reef Fishery Research and Monitoring
  - Data / information gap; some requires urgent management interventions
- Shark Fisheries Monitoring
  - Keystone species, regulates ecosystem function, high economic tourism value
- Capacity Building
