  - ◆ Identifying CTI Champions within the Regional Secretariat, DPs, NCCs, other stakeholders

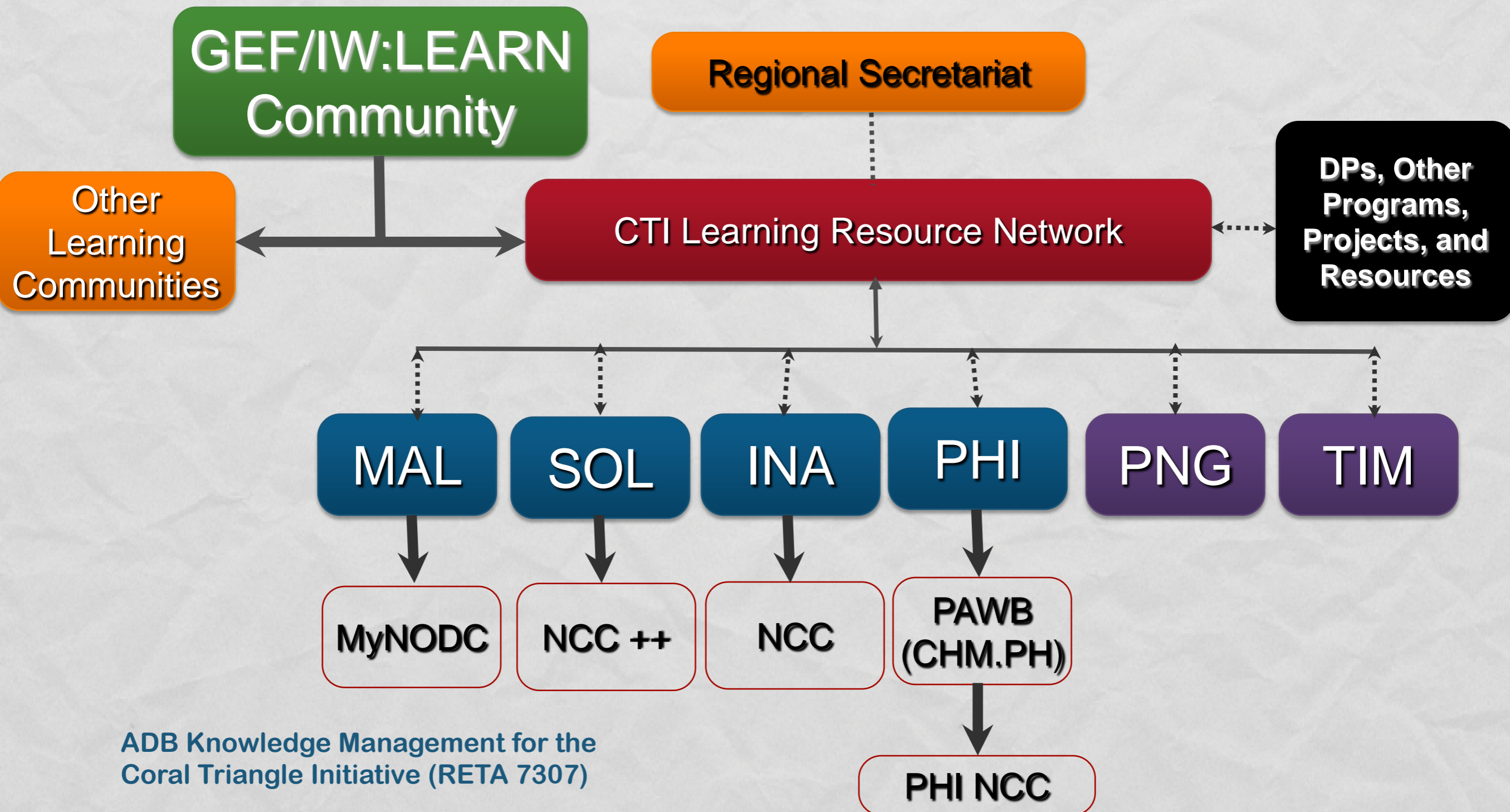
# Leveraging on Existing Learning Platforms
