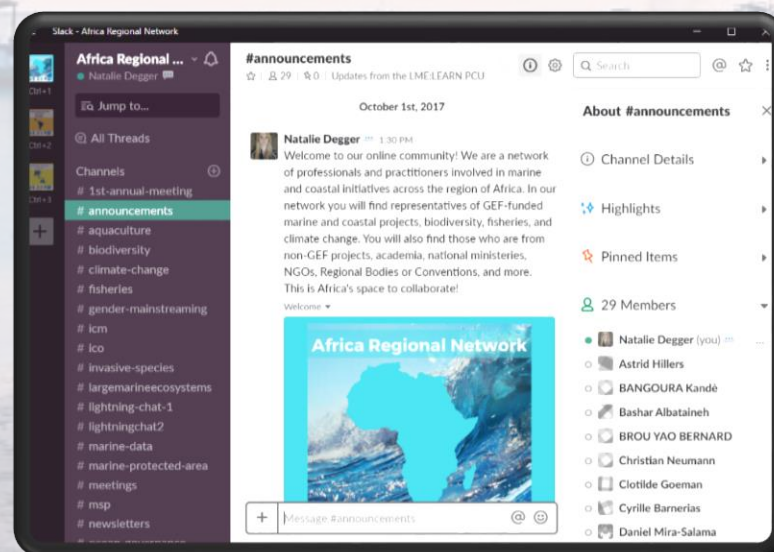

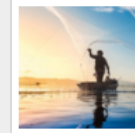

Environmental Economics for Marine Ecosystem Management Toolkit

The purpose of this toolkit is to show how environmental economic methods can be used to produce information to support decision-making in the context of LME, MPA, ICM, marine spatial planning (MSP) and climate change adaptation.



Large Marine Ecosystems Strategic Approach Toolkit

A strategy may be defined as "a plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall aim".
