
GEF International Waters and LMEs:

• 20 LME projects globally with 110 GEF recipient countries working together with 20 non-recipient countries on their shared LMEs.

• UNDP, UNEP, and FAO have led these regional efforts with GEF financing . In addition, GEF has partnered with the World Bank to foster investments in sustainable fisheries and reduction of land-based pollution.

• GEF has provided \$247 million in grants that accompanied \$3.25 billion in investments from countries, partners, and the World Bank to add to the impact of the regional GEF LME projects.
