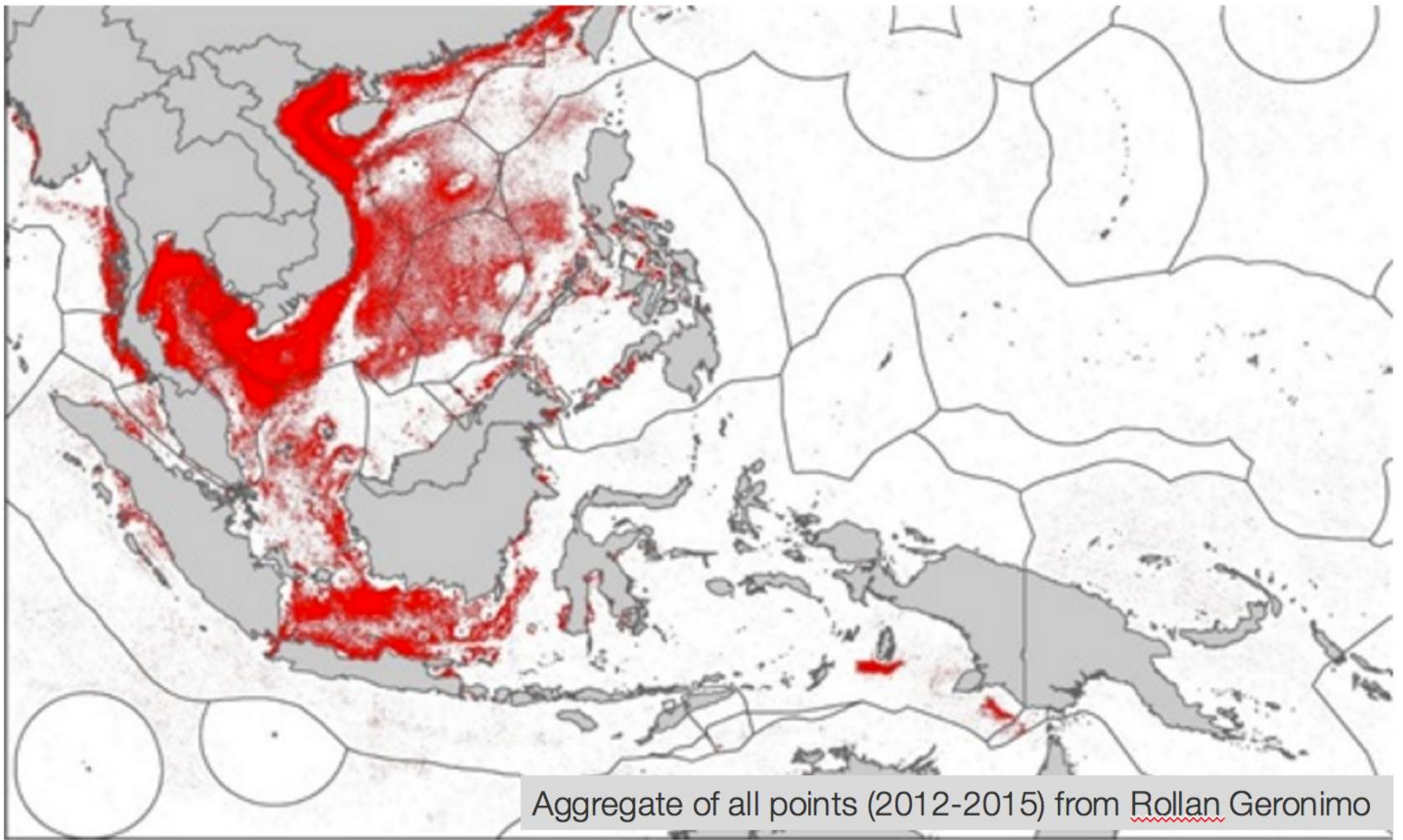

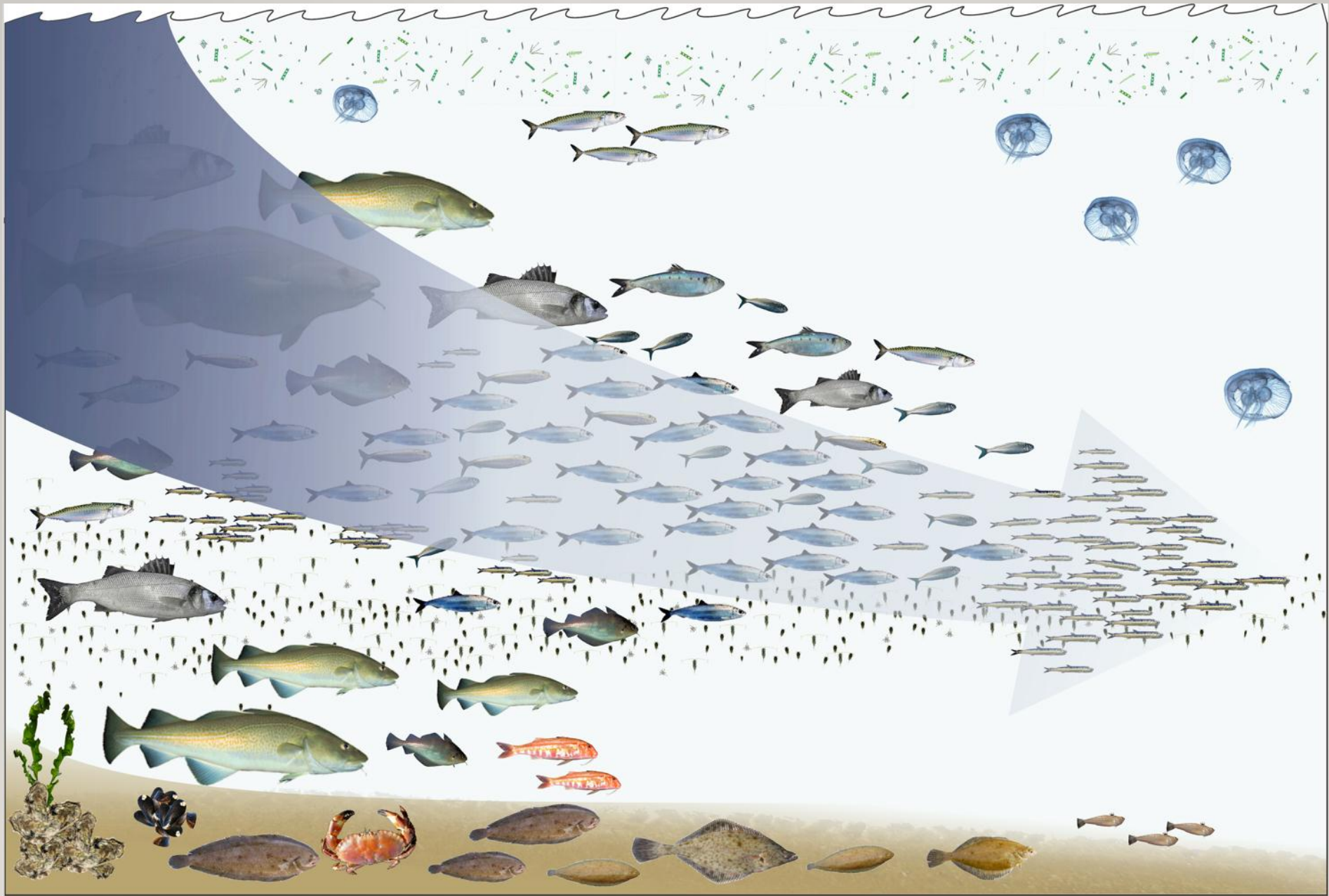

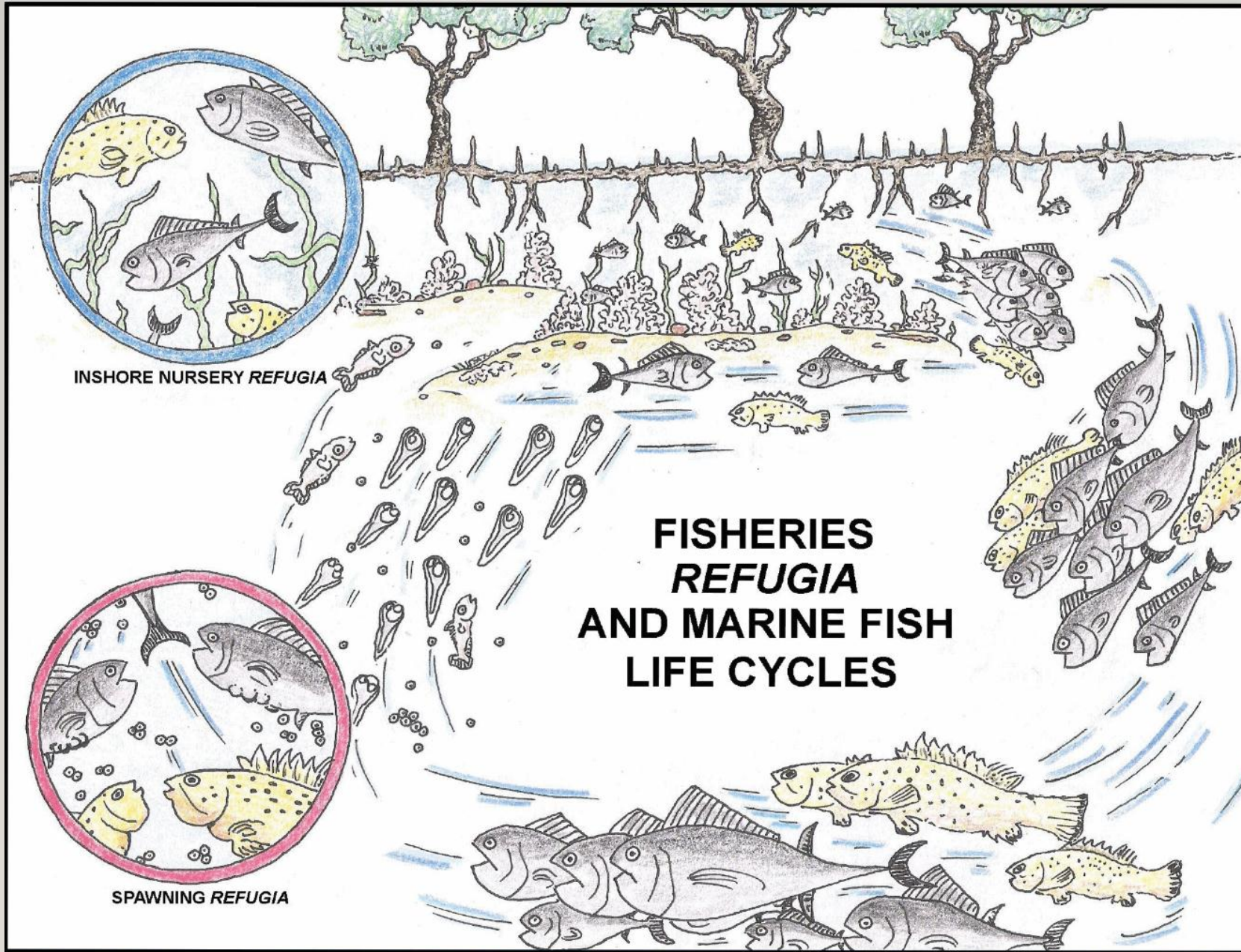
Aggregate of all points (2012-2015) from Rollan Geronimo



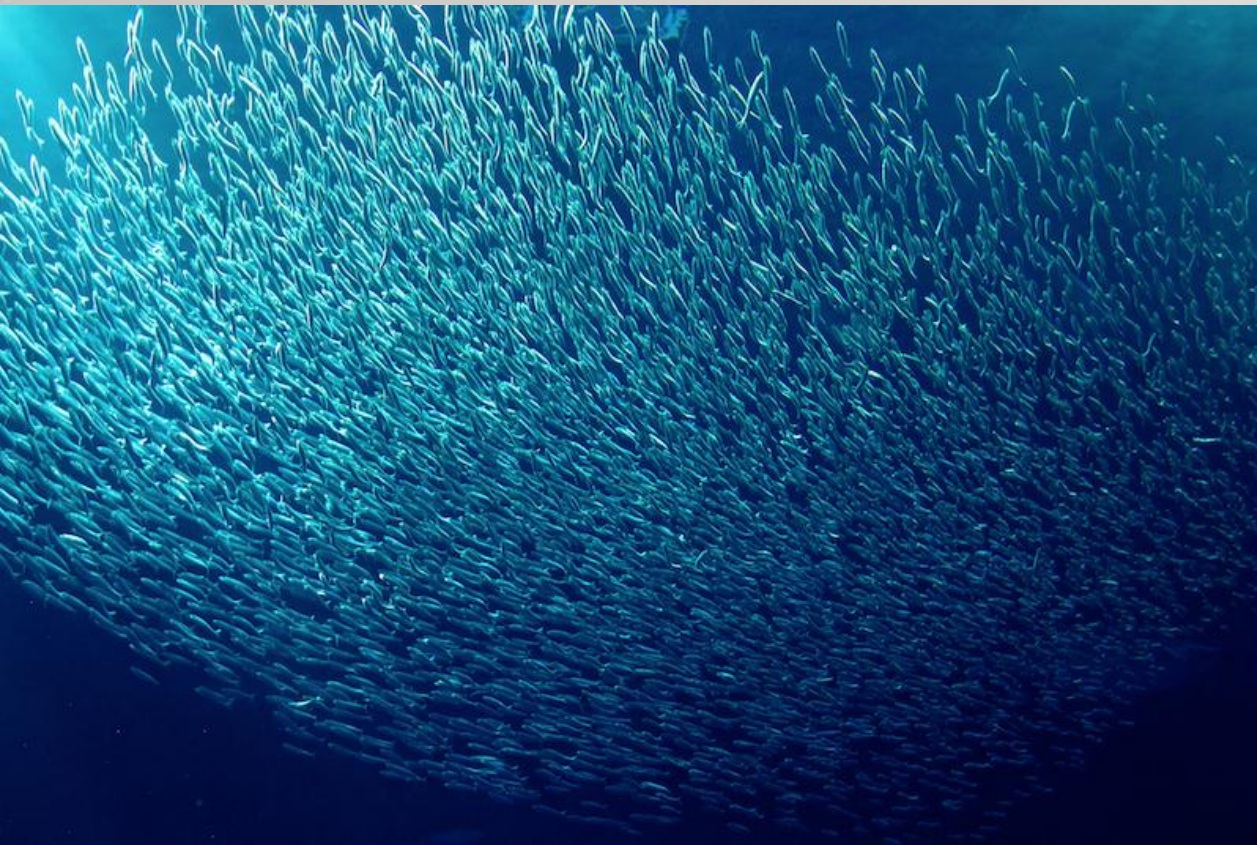
In 2014, 1.86 million vessels of which almost 99% are fishing vessels less than 24 meters in length.



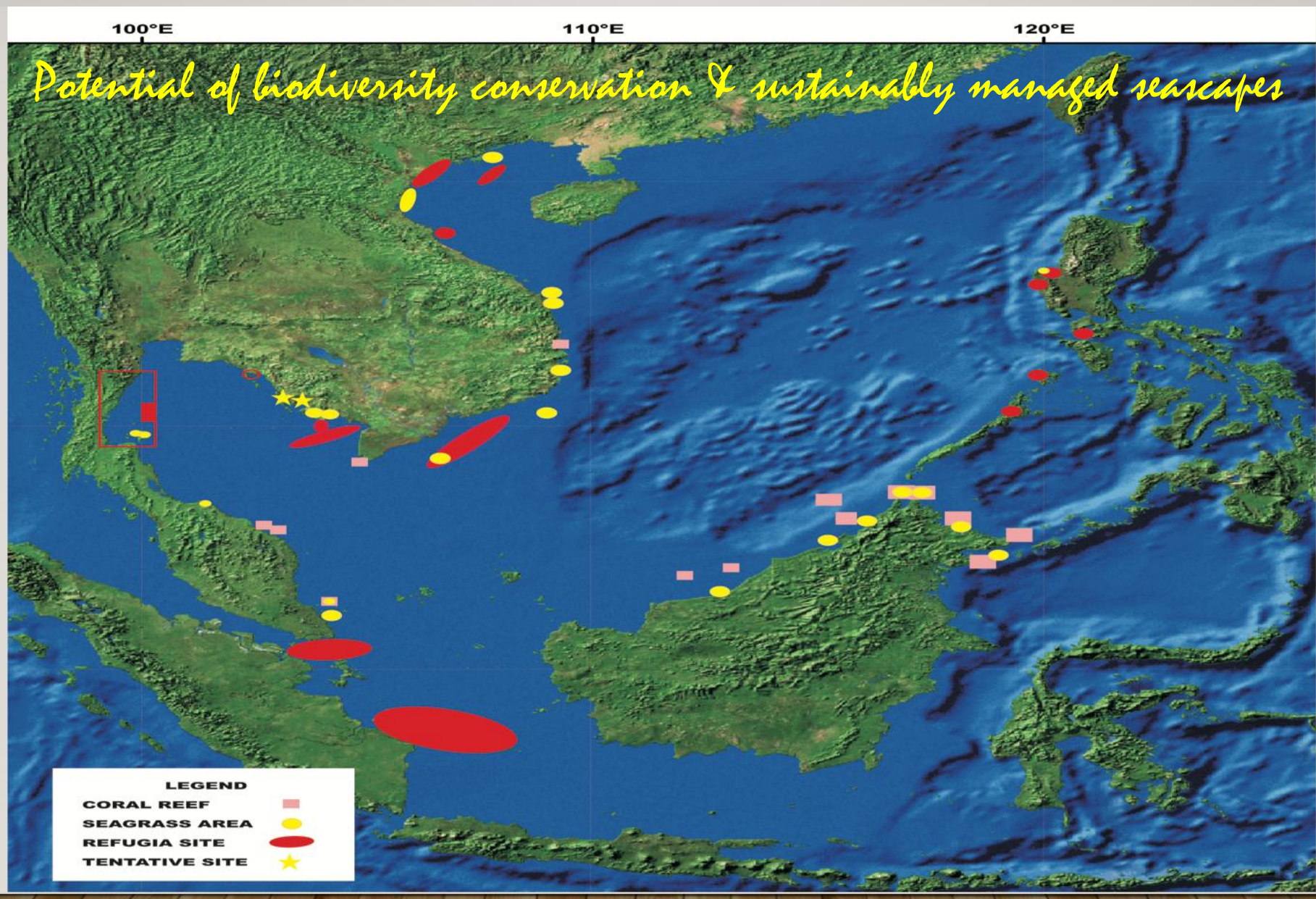




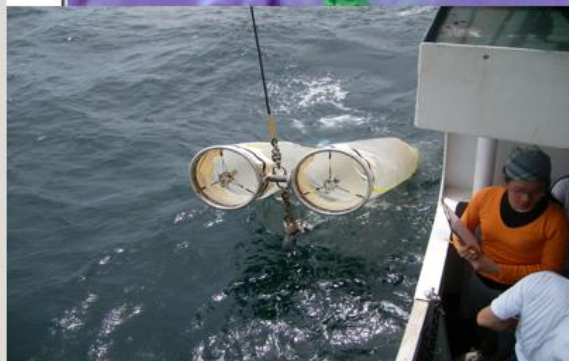
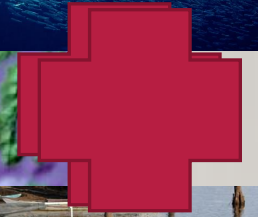
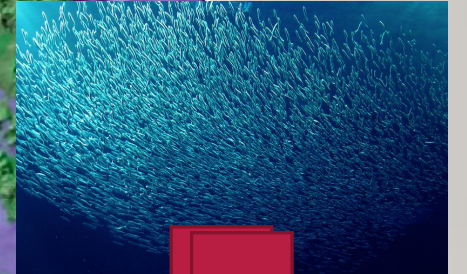
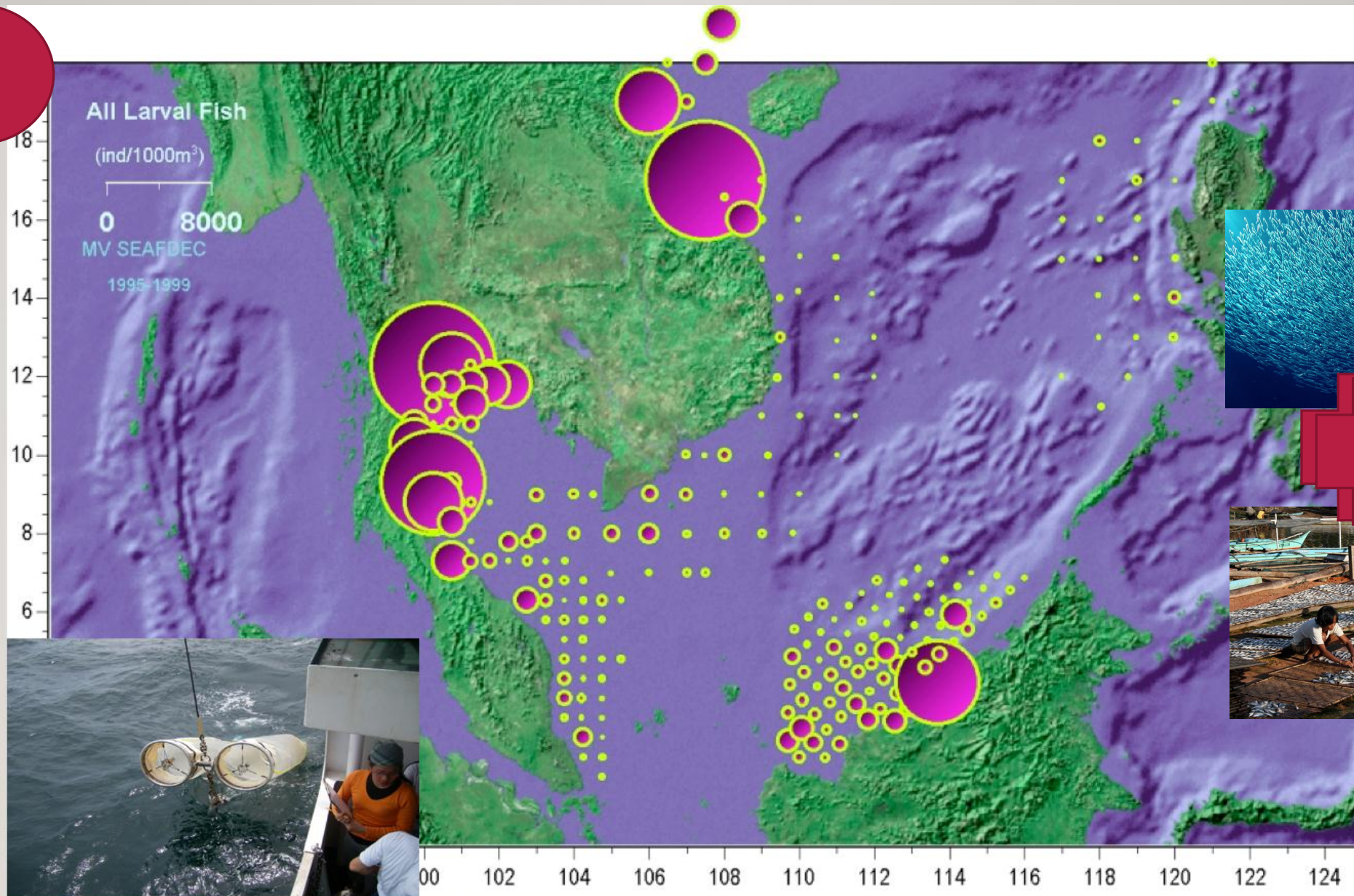








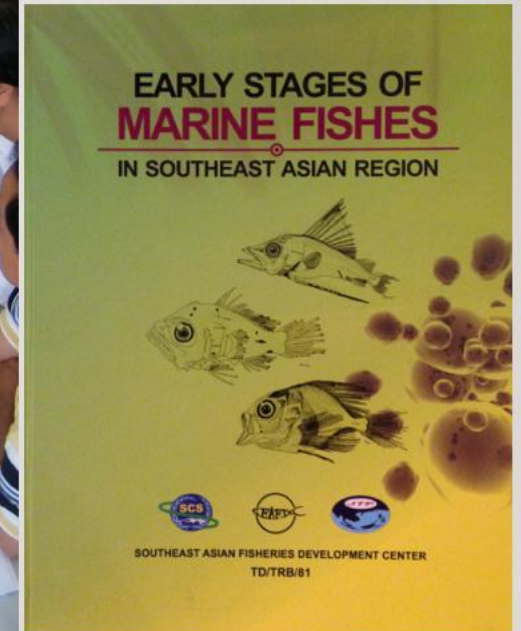
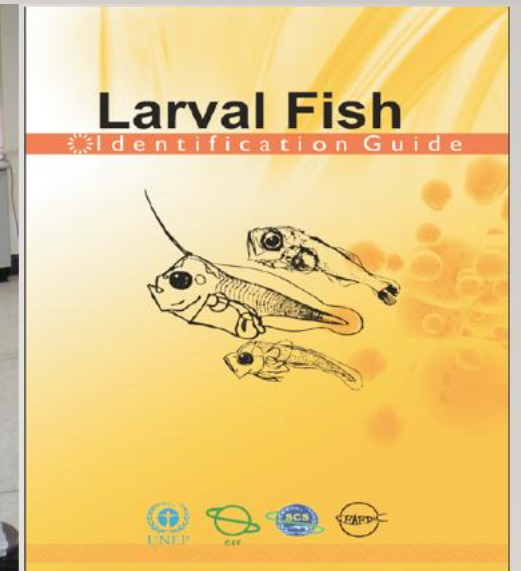
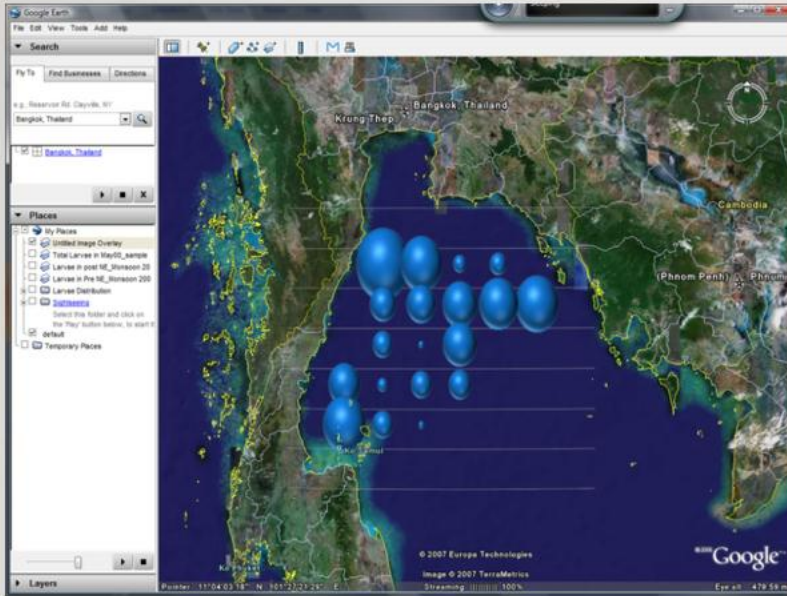
