Ensuring sustainability after projects end

- Plan for sustainability from the start:
 - Open data agreements
 - long-term maintenance of websites / data portals
 - using IW:LEARN bibliography & repository
- Incentives → how to make sure people do this?

Avoiding duplication

- Databases everyone builds their own atlas / portal etc.
- Everyone has specific needs. How can duplication be avoided better?
- Reporting on the same indicators by multiple institutions & projects

Indicators

- Add richness / context to guidelines
- Purpose / benefits of common core indicators?
- Linking with SDG targets

- Improving delivery of DIM documents
 - Format reports are long and heavy
 - Leaflets? Checklist? Storymaps? Videos?
 - Training events?
- Institutional / organizational map or database of key institutions & stakeholders ("Who's who?")
 - Data providers
 - Government bodies
 - NGOs & industry
 - Legislation, policy (national, regional / global)

Suggested actions

- Provide workshop report and outputs to IW:LEARN and participants (who: PEMSEA)
- Tools
 - Check project profile and provide updates (who: Projects to IW:LEARN)
 - Contact IW:LEARN to request assistance on specific needs for tools (who: Projects)
 - RSS feed/link on news (LME-level, project level), documents, events (who: Projects)
