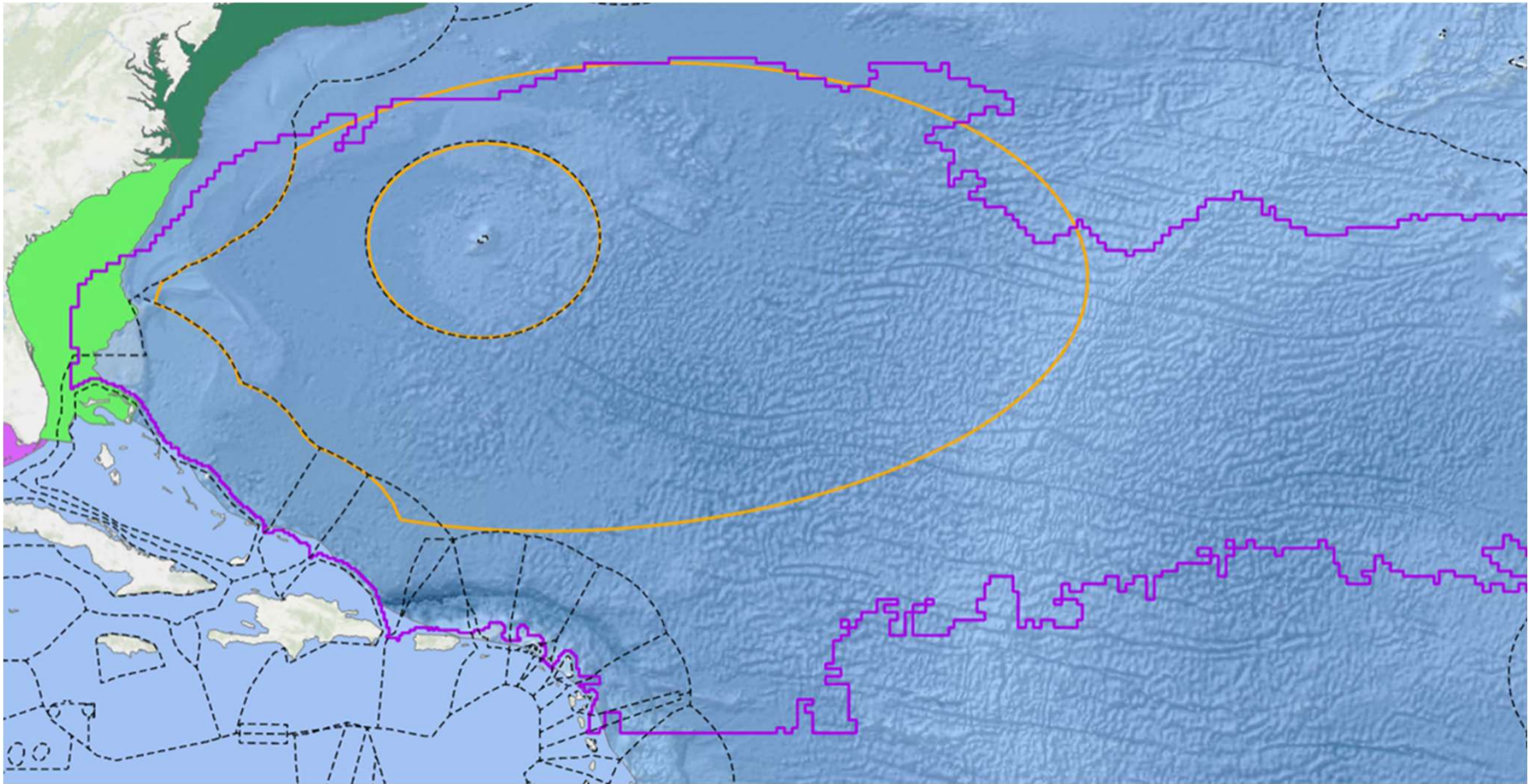

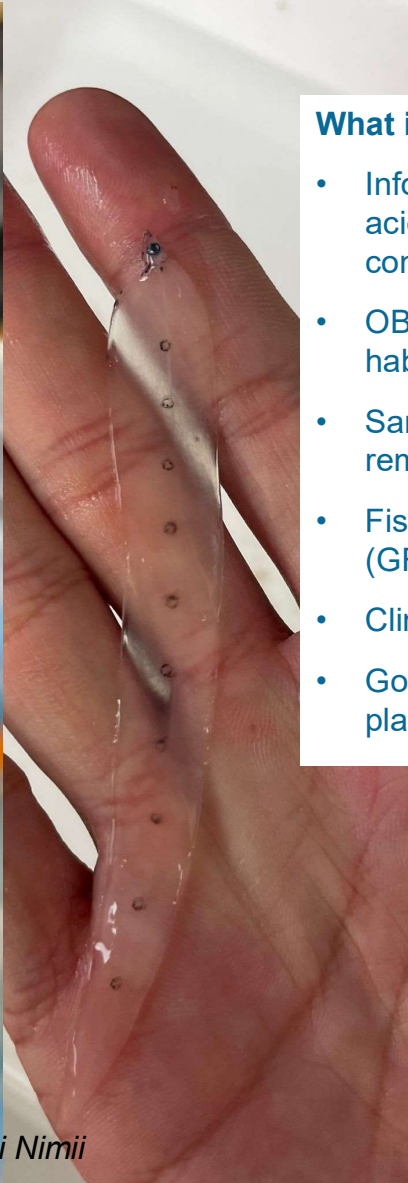

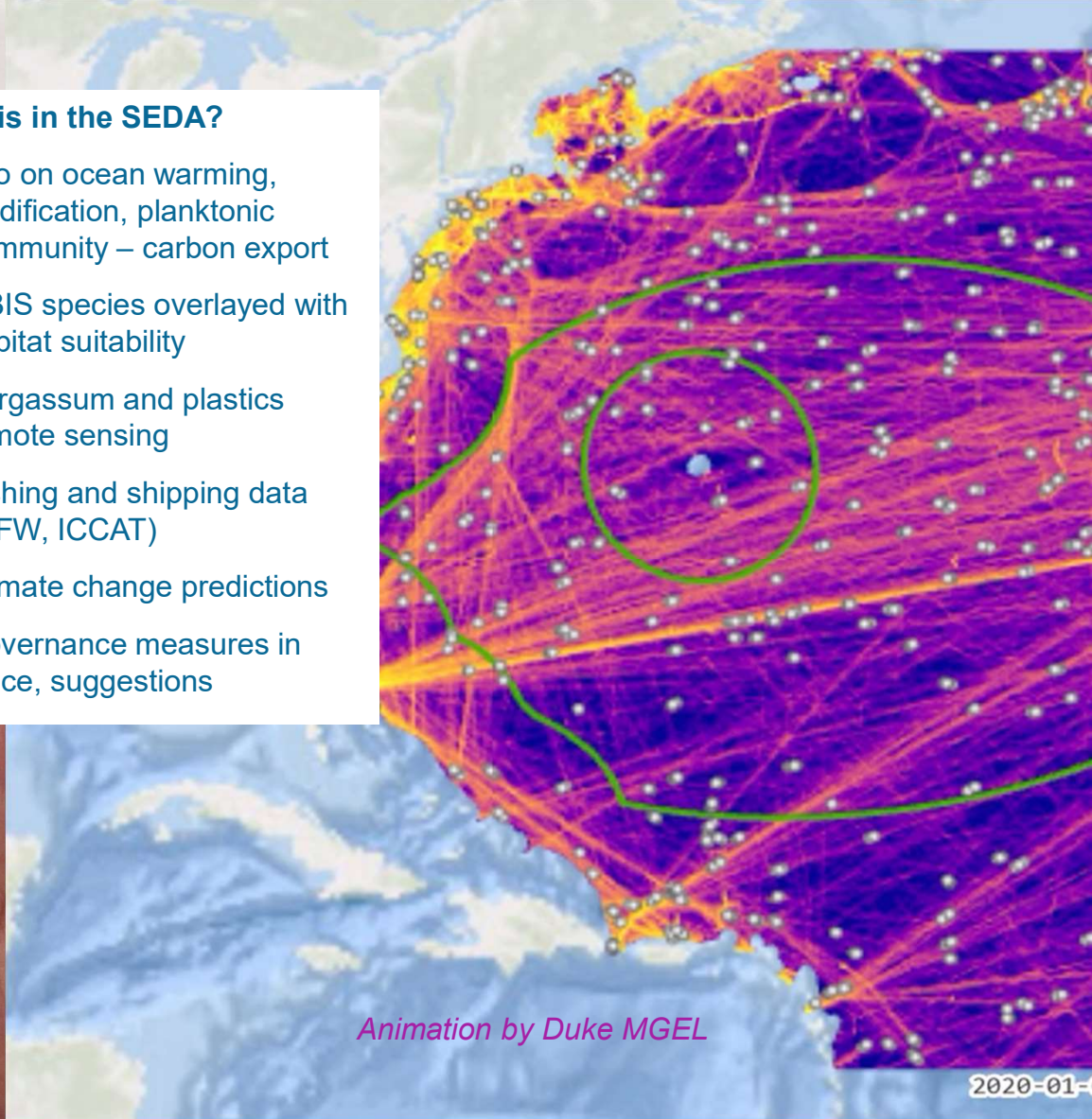

- Info on ocean warming, acidification, planktonic community – carbon export
- OBIS species overlaid with habitat suitability
- Sargassum and plastics remote sensing
- Fishing and shipping data (GFW, ICCAT)
- Climate change predictions
- Governance measures in place, suggestions
